1. The Importance of Knowing God

Colossians 1:10 To walk worthily of the Lord to please Him in all things, bearing fruit in every good work and growing by the full knowledge of God.

Daniel 11:32 The people who know their God will show strength and take action.

2. God Having Manifested Himself—Creation

Romans 1:19-20 That which is known of God is manifest within them, for God manifested it to them. For the invisible things of Him, both His eternal power and divine characteristics, have been clearly seen since the creation of the world, being perceived by the things made...

3. God Having Spoken—the Bible
